



## Southern Cross Bingo/Housie

### Game Rules

- All participants must be financial members of the Canberra Southern Cross Club.
- All books and specials must be pre-purchased from Southern Cross Club Jamison. Players using unidentified books or specials will not be eligible to claim a prize or continue to play for the remainder of the session.
- Under normal circumstances, players are expected to play their books and specials continually for the full session. Players are not permitted to select or request any specific book or special.
- Membership cards must be displayed on the table during each Bingo/Housie session.
- The prize money allocated for each session will be announced by the Housie Caller prior to the session commencing.
- Once a number has been displayed on the number board, and has been called, it is part of the game. The caller's decision is final. Members cannot claim a win on a number called before the last number called.
- In the event a number is displayed, and not called, and the next number is displayed and called, both numbers will be considered part of the game.
- It is the responsibility of the player to stop the Housie Caller if a winning claim is made. No further claims will be accepted once payment has been made.
- The numbers displayed on the winning ticket must correspond with those on the Housie Board to allow a player to claim it as a winning ticket.
- Numbers called in error can be brought to the attention of the Housie Caller. If an error occurs, however, verbal missed calls will not be addressed after a winning claim.
- Black or dark markers are not to be used – it is the player's responsibility to ensure their tickets can be read. If the tickets are unable to be read, then no claims will be recognised.
- Players are to sign for winnings over \$500. Winnings over \$500 will be independently verified by another player.
- All players must demonstrate courtesy towards other patrons and staff during the Bingo/Housie session. Noise should be kept to a minimum (please switch off mobile phones) and a pleasant level of behaviour is to be maintained at all times.
- Players are not permitted to participate in:
  - Sales related to the conduct of Housie/Bingo during a session.
  - In the calling of a game during a session.
  - In the administration of Housie/Bingo during a session.

### **Reservation of Seating**

- Entry doors to the Housie room will open at 8.30am when tickets are ready to be sold. No seats may be reserved before the doors open.
- Players may reserve one seat for themselves only.
- Reservation of seats can only be made on the day the session is held. Reserving seats from session to session is not permitted and will be removed.
- Reserved seats that are not occupied with members belongings 15minutes prior to the start of each session will be removed.
- Players are not permitted to dictate who may sit in reserved seats. Seating is limited to one seat per player.
- Seats are not to be used for feet, handbags or shopping items.
- Furniture in the Bingo/Housie Room is not to be moved.
- Any disputes or disruptions over seating may result in the player being asked to leave for the day.

### **Costs**

- \$20 Full Book / \$10 Half Book \$1 per Jackpot Sheet
- \$20 Full Book / \$10 Half Book \$1 per Jackpot Sheet

\*Jackpot tickets can only be purchased by members who have purchased a minimum half book for the session.

### Games and Prizes –Friday and Saturday

- 17 x Games played @ \$30 per line/ \$70 per House = \$1700.00
- 3x Specials Game played @ \$30 per line/ \$100 per House = \$390.00
- 1x Jackpot Game played @ \$100 per line/ \$1000 per House = \$1100.00
- Total \$3190 per session

### Terms and Conditions

- The promotion is open to all members of the Canberra Southern Cross Club Limited, excluding Directors, Staff, and Contractors, Spouses and/or partners.
- Staff are not permitted to play or mark patron's tickets at any time.
- Members are eligible to win more than one prize.
- Members are not permitted to have laptops, recording or analysing devices in the Housie Room.
- Where practical, all books and specials used in a given game of Housie shall have the same serial number or identifier. These serial numbers on tickets will be checked prior to the payment of the prize money being awarded to the winner(s)
- In the event of a malfunction or total electronic system breakdown, the Manager on duty may decide to postpone Housie to another time.
- The Manager on Duty's decision on all matters is final. Any complaints are to be made in writing and addressed to the Venue Manager.
- Only food and beverages purchased in the club can be consumed in the club.
- Persons under the age of 18 are not eligible to participate or be present in the Bingo/Housie Room.
- Intoxicated persons are not eligible to participate
